

BFM 2021 Covid-19 Protocol and Setup Requirements

In addition:

Food Vendors:

- May be required to implement additional safe guards as dictated by the Nova Scotia Department of Environment, Inspection Compliance and Enforcement, Public Health Officer at time of applying for their 2021 Food Permit.

All Vendors:

- Will supply their own table to display products, are responsible for timely set-up and take-down. Tablecloths are optional but encouraged to give each vendor space a tidy appearance.
- Will supply their own chair (if needed).
- Will provide hand sanitizer (with pump dispenser) for their own and customer use.
- Will supply spray disinfectant and paper towel to sanitize items on their table.
- Will devise a method (chalk, duct tape, etc.) to mark social distancing lines in front of their vendor table.
- Will space tables at least 2 metres (6 feet) apart from one another.

This year the BFM is encouraging vendors to use a tent style cover to provide protection from the outdoor elements. In addition, the curb appeal of having a cluster of tents within the heart of the Village of Baddeck will attract customers curious to see this local attraction!
